 - 4.1.1 Answer Yes, Contractor needs to install new ceiling under base bid. Demo Note 13 called out the wrong detail number, See RCP **5/A31-1** and spec section 09 51 23 Acoustical Tile Ceilings.
- 4.2 Question 2. Drawing A11-1 new work, note 12, provide heavy duty printer stand, model number of printer is needed.
 - 4.2.1 Answer See attached example model cut sheet.
- 4.3 Question -3. What security contractor does the work for the owner?
