

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for OMB/DFM Contract No. **MC3806000016 – Plummer Community Corrections Center – Fence Replacement Phase 2**, will be received by the State of Delaware, Office of Management and Budget, Division of Facilities Management, at 540 S. DuPont Highway, Suite 1, Dover, Delaware 19901 until 2:00PM local time on May 14, 2020, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Conference Room. Bidder bears the risk of late delivery. Any bids received after the stated time will be returned unopened.

Project involves the replacement of the perimeter security fence system along the East and South East perimeter of the site. A new sliding cantilever vehicle gate will also be installed at the entrance off Todds Lane.

A **MANDATORY** Pre-Bid Meeting will be held on April 23, 2020, at 9:00 AM at DFM Lg Conf Room for the purpose of establishing the listing of subcontractors and to answer questions. Representatives of each party to any Joint Venture must attend this meeting. **ATTENDANCE OF THIS MEETING IS A PREREQUISITE FOR BIDDING ON THIS CONTRACT.**

Site visits will be scheduled separately from the Pre-bid Meeting. A security (background) clearance approval is required of all attendees intending to visit the site on the selected date. Security Clearance Request Forms will be handed out at the Pre-Bid Meeting.

Sealed bids shall be addressed to the Division of Facilities Management, 540 S. DuPont Highway, Suite 1, Dover, Delaware 19901. The outer envelope should clearly indicate: "**OMB/DFM CONTRACT NO. Each bid must be accompanied by a bid security equivalent to ten percent of the bid amount and all additive alternates. The successful bidder must post a performance bond and payment bond in a sum equal to 100 percent of the contract price upon execution of the contract. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities therein. The Owner may extend the time and place for the opening of the bids from that described in the advertisement, with not less than two calendar days notice by certified delivery, facsimile machine or other electronic means to those bidders receiving plans.
