AV, Data, & Electric Scope of Work Summary (by Owner)

Farmington / Felton:


- SOW out with the AV vendor to provide the disconnect services for the displays (4) & 2 cameras.
 - o Will modify to have them remove the display cabling from behind current walls AND
 - Remove the ceiling projector (no re-use in F/F space)
 - o This will happen in early October
- Restoration
 - The AV supplier is on notice for the subsequent reconnect (date TBD)
 - They will be "flipping" the room displays to reconfigure space (front & back)
 - o We need to have them re-install the video cables that they 'recovered'.
 - There is one display that will remain in current location near door. We cannot deal with the fire strobe relocation.
 - The "new front" of room will have the 2 displays set up to avoid conflict with the fire strobe at that wall.
 - Cameras will be placed similar to current situation --- 1 audience facing & 1
 podium facing
 - Electrical SOW to be addressed separate from this project. (NOT AV supplier task)
 - Need 2 new high outlets for the 2 displays in the "new front" of room
 - Need 1 high outlet for the 1 display being relocated to the "new back" of room
 - Need to evaluate electrical needs for PC and podium at the "new front" of room
 - o Electrical Related BUT NOT to support AV or the technology area
 - The current Leviton lighting control system has issues.
 - Unclear as to scope of current Leviton system It is in F/F room BUT it "may" also control the 2nd floor Fenwick room (there is a Leviton scene control there)
 - NEED new lighting controls in F/F the "new front" of room. (This will be a "3 way" type switch solution. Control (switches) near main door AND Controls (switches) near podium.
 - The lighting controls needs to be 'flexible' enough to deal with the "traditional" florescent fixtures AND the "can" fixtures that appear to have dimming features now.
 - Data/Network separate supplier NOT AV nor Electrical contractors.
 - Need to install ~ 6 new drops in the "new front" of room.
 - Data drops in rear will be removed to leave only 2.

Bethany Room

- AV supplier to remove Bethany AV components (TV's, Camera, table interface, & component rack.)
- They will 'most likely' need to remove behind the wall wires as the wiring is near the exterior wall that will be worked.
- Restoration Should return to current layout state. No other provisions planned.

- 1. Contractor to relocate existing plywood wall support for monitors 1 & 2 and patch / repair existing wall.
- 2. Contractor to install new wall support for relocated monitor 3 and patch / repair existing wall.
- 3. Contractor to confirm location of wall supports with owner prior to installation.
- 4. Contractor to remove blank wall plates identified by owner and patch / repair all walls.
- **5**. Contractor to coordinate with others under state contract providing electrical / IT / video services.
