

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for **OMB/DFM Contract No. MJ1002000001 – Townsend Building – Renovation – Phase II**, will be received by the State of Delaware, Office of Management and Budget, Division of Facilities Management, in the reception area of the Facilities Management Office in the Thomas Collins Building, 540 S. DuPont Highway, Suite 1 (Third Floor), Dover, DE 19901 until 2:00 p.m. local time on Thursday, September 13, 2012, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Conference Room. Bidder bears the risk of late delivery. Any bids received after the stated time will be returned unopened.

Project involves renovation of the north half of the first floor and the entire second floor of the Townsend Building located in Dover, Delaware. Renovations include all interior systems (mechanical, electrical, architectural).

Attention is called to construction schedule as detailed in the Bid Documents.
