- 3. Bids will be due March 16, 2015 at 2:00 p.m. in the reception area of the Facilities Management Office in the Thomas Collins Building, 540 S. DuPont Highway, Suite 1 (Third Floor), Dover, DE 19901, attention: John Dunham. If the bid date and time change, the revised date and time will be issued via written addendum. Please allow extra time when submitting bids to account for possible delays. No late bids will be considered.
- 4. One (1) original and one (1) copy of the bid must be submitted along with one (1) original of a Bid Bond equal to ten percent of the bid price including alternates, if applicable. A Performance

Bond equal to 100 percent of the contract amount must also be posted upon execution of the contract. Bond forms required are in the specifications. No construction schedules are required with the bid. The Bid Bond must be submitted on the form shown in the specifications. The prime bidder must submit a copy of their Delaware Business License with their bids. Failure to do so will cause a bid to be rejected.

- 5. The subcontractor list must accompany the Bid Form and be fully completed in order to submit a qualifying bid. The prime general contractor and all subcontractors must be licensed to practice their trade in the State of Delaware and the City of Smyrna at the time of execution of the contract.
- 6. General Contractors who wish to receive addenda directly and be on the bidders list must purchase a minimum of one (1) set of bid documents from Davis, Bowen & Friedel, Inc. for \$200.00.
- 7. Working hours will be Monday Friday, 7 a.m. 6 p.m. Weekends may be available with 48 hours advanced notice. The site superintendent must sign in all the workers at GP2 and pick up badges. When working on the weekend, the site superintendent must sign in with security.
- 8. The area of work will not be occupied during construction. The remainder of the building will be occupied and in use during construction. Temporary walls constructed for the abatement were left up. Additional temporary walls and doors noted on D1 are not needed.
- 9. <u>Funding</u>: The project is state funded. Prevailing Wage Rates will be required. For bidding purposes, contractors should refer to the rates and benefits included in the specification. The general contractor will be responsible to send wage reports to the Department of Labor.
- 10. <u>Submissions</u>: The contractor will be responsible for building permit submission and the associated fees to the City of Smyrna. The Office of the Fire Marshal has approved the drawings for the project. Impact fees will be addressed in a later addendum.
- 11. <u>Schedule</u>: There is a strict set schedule to complete the work associated with this contract. It is anticipated that notice to proceed will be sometime at the end of March, and the project must be substantially complete by September 11, 2015.
- 12. The contractor will be responsible for having a supervisor on site at all times during work of any subcontractors or their own forces, including punch-list work.
- 13. The Owner will provide electric, water service, and toilet facilities until they are decommissioned in the project area. An area on site will be established for a contractor staging and material storage at the pre-construction meeting.
- 14. There will be fire alarm and sprinkler modifications design/build as part of the general

contractors' scope of work. The existing fire alarm devices will be bagged but will remain active. Anaconda is DHCI's current vendor and Advantech is the State's security vendor.

- 15. Criminal background checks are not required.
- 16. This is a smoke free facility and campus. All smokers must go off grounds at Sunnyside Road to smoke.
- 17. An additional walk-through will take place Tuesday, March 3<sup>rd</sup> at 8:30 a.m. and Thursday, March 5<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m. All attendees are to meet at the Prickett building entry.
- 18. The existing nurse call system will be demolished.
- 19. The State is responsible for all electrical work associated with the heat pumps. Refer to Note 4 on Sheet E3.

Any changes, additions or deletions to these minutes should be submitted in writing to Davis, Bowen & Friedel, Inc., within ten (10) days.
