

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for **OMB/DFM Contract No. MJ3804000088 – Vaughn Correctional Center – Automotive Skills Facility** will be received by the State of Delaware, Office of Management and Budget, Division of Facilities Management, in the reception area of the Facilities Management Office in the Thomas Collins Building, 540 S. DuPont Highway, Suite 1 (Third Floor), Dover, DE 19901 until 2:00 p.m. local time on Thursday, October 27, 2016, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Conference Room. Bidder bears the risk of late delivery. Any bids received after the stated time will be returned unopened.

The purpose of this project is to construct a pole barn building located outside of the secured area to operate as the Automotive Skills Facility at the Vaughn Correctional Center in Smyrna, Delaware. Approximate square footage of the building will be 8,000 s.f. with office, changing room, tool and parts rooms and restrooms.
