## To answer the following questions:

1. Why would the radios need to be LTR capable? Are they hooking into another system not related or specified in this bid?

The school radios as well as the supervisor channel works on LTR format. Since they are not changing over to digital the supervisor and support vehicle radios will need to be compatible with this format.

2. Is this a totally new radio system? If so then why would it have to talk to Kenwood only software?

It is a totally new radio system but there is no sense in replacing the AVL software so that is why it states that. I guess if someone wants to propose a new system that won't talk to the Kenwood software they could add a line item for purchasing software compatible with their radios.

3. The bid says Kenwood or equivalent. However, you are specifying a particular item and Kenwood platform which is not compatible with anything else. Are you saying strictly "digital" would be equivalent?

The Kenwood digital platform is compatible with Icom radios and others. The format is called NXDN.
