Red Clay Consolidated School District Dickinson High School Pavement Improvements Contract # RCCD21050-PAVEMENT

July 24, 2020

This Addendum No. 2 becomes part of the Contract Documents. Please acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in the space provided on Page 2 of the Bid Form.

The Red Clay School District may decide to cancel in-person instruction. In which case, the Contractor would be allowed to work during school hours. A third base bid has been added to reflect this option. A revised bid form is included with this Addendum.

The following questions were received prior to the last date of submission as stipulated in Addendum No. 1 (Thursday, July 23, 2020 at 5:00 pm.):

1. Question: On Page 2 of the bid form it say we will start project on March 12th 2012 and finish before Aug 3 2012. If not there is liquidated damages of \$250/day. Please advise.

Answer: This sentence has been replaced with the following: "Should I/We be awarded this contract, I/We pledge to achieve substantial completion of all the work within 60 calendar days of the Notice to Proceed." A revised bid form is included with this Addendum.

2. Question: Detail: 4" Perforated Pipe Underdrain – Listed in Diagram but not on actual plans.

Answer: The perforated pipe underdrain will not be utilized.

3. Will there be additional parking bumpers available or should we be including them in our bid?

Answer: The Contractor will be required to provide parking bumpers to replace the existing roll curb, as identified on the project drawings. In addition, existing bumper blocks damaged by the Contractor during moving and reinstallation are to be replaced at no cost. Where existing bumper blocks are broken, the school district will provide replacement bumper blocks.



4. Clarification on project logistics if school is in session.

Answer: If the Red Clay School District decides to hold in-person instruction, work performed during the school year (beginning August 24, 2020) shall be performed during the hours of 6:00 PM through 6:00 AM. The Contractor may close the work area to traffic during this time.

5. I remember in the pre-bid meeting that striping was to be done with waterborne paint, but it says in the plans that it should be epoxy or thermo. Could you please confirm this.

Answer: All pavement markings shall be performed using parking lot grade acrylic water-borne striping paint. The revised drawings provided with Addendum No. 1 were updated to reflect this requirement.

6. For the removal of the asphalt rolled curb – it says replace 90. Is that referring to the new curb or parking bumpers. If it is parking bumpers, should that be included in the bid or will those be supplied? Also, will those be designated for each spot or will they fit together flush?

Answer: The Contractor shall remove the existing roll curb and install concrete bumper blocks (supplied by the Contractor) in its place. Bumper blocks shall be centered within parking spaces. When no parking spaces are present, maintain same distance between bumper blocks.

7. Will it be permissible for an escalation clause?

Answer: No

8. Section TS-7 Undercutting, Paragraph 5.0 Basis of Payment states that 450 Cubic Yards of Undercutting is to be included in the Base Bid price. Considering that there is only about 300 SY of Full Depth Pavement Repair shown on the drawings this quantity would require an 18" undercut to generate 450 cubic yards. Is it correct to assume any reduction below the 450 cubic yards will be deducted from our base bid price at \$75.00 per cubic yard which is the specified unit price in the Bid Form?

Answer: The unit price for undercutting is an "Add" only price. A reduction in the base bid for quantities of undercutting less than 450 cubic yards will not be utilized.

Bids are due on Wednesday, July 29, 2020 at 1:00 pm. Bids should be submitted to the Red Clay Consolidated School District, Facilities Department, 1798 Limestone Road, Wilmington, DE 19804. To attend the bid opening, Contractors should report to the Stanton Middle School Main Office, located at 1800 Limestone Rd, Wilmington, DE 19804.
