1.04 PAYMENT

- A. Payment for Work governed by unit prices will be made on the basis of the actual measurements and quantities of Work that is incorporated in or made necessary by the Work and accepted by the StudioJAED, multiplied by the unit price.
- B. Payment will not be made for any of the following:
 - 1. Products wasted or disposed of in a manner that is not acceptable.
 - 2. Products determined as unacceptable before or after placement.
 - 3. Products not completely unloaded from the transporting vehicle.
 - 4. Products placed beyond the lines and levels of the required Work.
 - 5. Products remaining on hand after completion of the Work.
 - 6. Loading, hauling, and disposing of rejected Products.

1.05 DEFECT ASSESSMENT

- A. Replace Work, or portions of the Work, not conforming to specified requirements.
- B. If, in the opinion of StudioJAED, it is not practical to remove and replace the Work, StudioJAED will direct one of the following remedies:

 - 1. Provide temporary team trailers as shown on sheets C-502 and C-503. Price shall include all systems and components required to provide full functioning, code compliant installation including temporary foundation systems, accessible access, code compliant egress, compacted gravel walkways, lighting, air conditioning, power service. Price shall include removal of trailer and associated systems and components and lawn restoration. Price shall include 12 month lease of temporary team trailers.
- C. Alternate No. 3 - Temporary Trailers Extension at West Fields:
 - 1. Price per month for lease extension for one trailer at West Fields.

- G. Alternate No. 7 - New Conduit for Control Wiring at Main Stadium
 - 1. Provide one (1) 2" underground conduit and pull string from control booth to each light pole at Main Stadium as indicated on sketch SK-E.03. Wiring shall be by others.
- H. Alternate No. 8 - New Conduit for Stadium Lighting
 - 1. Provide four (4) 2 1/2" underground conduit from source panel, extending one conduit to each light pole at Main Stadium as indicated on sketch SK-E.03. Wiring in base bid.
- I. Alternate No. 9 - Cloud-Based Construction Management System:
 - 1. Provide and administer a Cloud-Based Construction Management System. System shall provide a platform to manage the following: Project Directory, Construction Documents, Specifications, RFIs, Submittals, Bulletins, ASIs, Change Orders and Meetings.
- J. Alternate No. 10 - Excavate and Fill at Former UST Location
 - 1. Excavate unsuitable fill material at former underground storage tank location. Provide shoring as required. Remove and dispose of material off-site. Import, place and compact

suitable fill appropriate for placement of new building footings in accordance with Section 3120000 - Earth Moving. Tank removal and hole have been cleared by DNREC. Approximate sized of required excavation is 25 feet by 35 feet by 12 feet deep. Location is adjacent to generator outside of the loading dock.
