ADDENDUM #1

The following questions have been received with the following responses provided.

1. Will Delmarva pay for these consulting services or will they be paid for from the PSC budget?	Payments for PSC consulting services are made from the PSC Appropriated Special Fund budget.
2. What is the budget limit for Task 1 and Task 2 and/or the total cost?	There is no budget limit; however, overall cost and effective use of resources will be considered in any contract award.
3. What has the PSC paid in the past for similar projects?	Payments for projects at the PSC have varied from simple one topic testimonies to complex generation proposal analyses. Payments have usually varied from \$1,000 to \$400,000. There have not been any similar projects.
4. During the project, will it be possible for the consultant to visit Delmarva and interview the responsible parties or will all information gathering be through formal discovery for both tasks?	Information for Task 1 will be primarily through formal discovery; however, interviews with responsible parties may be arranged. Information for Task 2 will be primarily through workshops, discussion, interviews and public comment sessions
5. Does Delaware employ "technical conferences" to supplement formal discovery?	Delaware can use technical conferences, but typically uses more informal workshops to supplement discovery, particularly around Task 2.

What is the expected turnaround time from submittal of an interrogatory to the receipt of the response?</p>	<p>The Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure will usually permit a 15 day turnaround. 2.6.6 In rate or other expedited cases, responses to discovery must be served no later than fifteen (15) days, excluding holidays and weekends, after service of the discovery, unless otherwise directed by the Commission, the designated Presiding Officer or Hearing Examiner. In all other cases the information requested shall be provided within thirty (30) days of service, unless otherwise directed by the Commission, Presiding Officer, or designated Hearing Examiner.</p>
<p>7. Why is there such a big schedule gap between testimony completion, August 16, 2013, and the evidentiary hearings in November 2013?</p>	<p>The schedule permits rebuttal testimony from all parties as may be needed and allows for time for potential settlement discussions prior to the November timeframe. However, all bidders should be aware that the procedural schedule is subject to change.</p>
<p>8. Can the original rate case testimony be supplemented later with information from Task 2?</p>	<p>Task 1 original rate case testimony will be based on discovery and any discussion conducted during the case schedule. Task 2 may be supplemented from Task 1, but Task 1 may not be supplemented from Task 2.</p>
<p>9. Is there a way for the results of the Task 2 to be introduced into the rate case or is it completely separate from a regulatory perspective?</p>	<p>Completely separate from a regulatory perspective.</p>
<p>10. Is there a way to access Delmarva's filings in both dockets on-line? If not, how can we review what has been filed to date? (We did find Delmarva's application in the rate case.)</p>	<p>Filings to date include: Delmarva's application on Dkt 13-115 is available on the PSC website. Staff's Motion to Investigate Delmarva's Reliability, Delmarva's Response and Public Notice for Intervention on Dkt 13-152 is also available on the PSC website under Electric Information, Important or Pending Cases.</p>
<p>11. How can we access the reliability goals in Regulation 50?</p>	<p>Regulation Docket 50 Rules are available under Delaware's Administrative Code, Title 26, §3007. Legal Matters on the PSC website.</p>
<p>12. How can we access Delmarva's annual reliability performance report?</p>	<p>Delmarva's Annual Planning and Performance Reports are available on the PSC website under Electric, Local, Regional and National Issues, Electric Reliability</p>
