- 6. Review Allowances
  - a. Allowance #1: \$50,000 for General concealed condition contingencies

- 1. Duffield Associates, under separate contract to Owner, will provide soil and concrete testing.

- 4. Selection of bidders is based on a complete bid, demonstrated ability to perform the work required and competitive pricing. Information for support of veteran, minority and woman owned businesses is available from the Office of Supplier Diversity at <u>https://gss.omb.delaware.gov/osd/</u>
- 5. Layout is to be provided by the General Contractor.
- 6. Excess soil material, as a result of the scope of work, will remain on site. Contractor to place on site at locations directed by Owner.
- 7. The data distribution to the new IDF and the trailers must be completed by May 2019. Remaining work may extend through 2019 in accordance with contractor provided work schedule.
- 8. Trenches may be permitted to remain "open" during evening hours provided all necessary protection, including orange safety fencing and signage, are provided. The Owner reserves the right to disallow this accommodation if the condition poses a hazard. All trenching, intended to be open, will require approval before allowing to remain "open".
- General Contractor is responsible to hire a ground penetrating radar technician to identify underground utilities along path of excavation. Previous vendor was GPRS, Contact person Grant McGuigan 484 280 2234.
