1	Will there be only three contracts awarded, or will DeIDOT consider awarding more than three?	Up to three (3) agreements may be awarded from this solicitation
2	On page 3, item D. Part I Section H, Additional Information - are firms limited to approximately five (5) pages in total for that section? For example, four (4) pages for the Rating Criteria Support Information and approximately one (1) page for the respective firm's current DeIDOT workload?	Part I Section H, Additional Information is limited to four pages that cover any information that directly relates to the firm's ability to meet the specific rating criteria listed in this RFP.
3	Is it desired for a firm to include a team of sub-consultants? (i.e. as an architecture firm, should engineering and other typically-used sub-consultants be	If the firm knows the subconsultants they wish to utilize, the firm should submit that information. The firm should also explain how the subconsultant will be utilized.
4	The SF330 form is requested to be used. Can a firm submit similarly organized information as an equivalent to the actual SF330 form file?	For consistency, please utilize the required FS330.
5	Is DeIDOT vendor registration separate from Bonfire registration?	Yes, please refer to this website for DeIDOT registration information: https://deldot.gov/Business/proservs/index.shtml?dc=consultants_registration
6	With respect to the RFP language "expert in the disciplines of Architecture, Engineering, and Transit Operations", can we assume that expert in transit operations is referring to the design and engineering of transit operations facilities, or is DeIDOT looking for another type of expertise.	"Expert in Transit operations" is referring to the design and engineering of transit operations facilities.
7	5. Architect-Engineer Qualifications; GSA SF330 of the RFP states that vendors are to follow the instructions for the SF330, but lists that vendors are to submit Section C, E, F, and H. Following the instructions would mean submitting a full SF330 with all sections A-H. Is DeIDOT expecting a full SF330 or just submission of the sections listed in the RFP?	Follow the instructions for the SF330, and add the Individual Agency Instructions listed.
8	The Bonfire portal indicates that questions are due by 2:00 on August 3, 2023. However, the RFP states that questions may be submitted up to 10 business days before the proposal due date. The due date listed in the RFP on Bonfire is August 17, 2023. Will vendors be able to submit questions through August 7, which is 10 days prior to the 8/17 due date?
