

## SECTION 00 11 16 – INVITATION TO BID

The Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control, Division of Fish & Wildlife will receive sealed bids for the Dobbinville Fishing Pier and Parking Lot Improvements, **Contract No. NAT-202401-DOBBINSVILLEPIER**, in the Auditorium, DNREC Building, 89 Kings Highway, Dover Delaware 19901, until **2:00 p.m., June 30, 2026**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Auditorium. Bidder bears the risk of late delivery. Any bid received after the stated time will be returned unopened.

Project will include:

1. Installation of steel pipe piles in the Delaware River.
2. Assemble pre-manufactured aluminum fishing pier on new steel pipe piles.
3. Renovation of existing gravel parking lot to paved lot.
4. Install signing and striping at renovated parking lot.
5. Install site lighting at renovated parking lot.

A **MANDATORY** Pre-Bid Meeting will be held at **10:00AM-sharp on June 10, 2026** at the Project Location, 0 River Road, New Castle, Delaware 19720, for the purpose of establishing the listing of subcontractors and to answer questions. Contractors arriving after 10:00AM-sharp will not be considered eligible for bidding. Representatives of each party to any Joint Venture must attend this meeting. **ATTENDANCE OF THIS MEETING IS A PREREQUISITE FOR BIDDING ON THIS CONTRACT.**

Each bid must be accompanied by a bid security equivalent to ten percent of the bid amount and all additive alternates. The successful bidder must post a performance bond and payment bond in a sum equal to 100 percent of the contract price upon execution of the contract. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities therein. The Owner may extend the time and place for the opening of the bids from that described in the advertisement, with not less than two calendar days' notice by certified delivery, facsimile machine or other electronic means to those bidders receiving plans.
