

SECTION 00 11 16 - INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids for **OMB / DFM Contract No. MC1002000824 for the Absalom Jones Senior Center - Roof Replacement**, will be received by the State of Delaware, Office of Management and Budget, Division of Facilities Management, at Haslet Armory, 122 Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd. South, Dover, DE 19901 until 2:00 p.m. local time on Wednesday, November 20, 2024, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bidder bears the risk of late delivery. Any bids received after the stated time will be returned unopened.

Project involves removal and replacement of the existing aluminum storefront windows and doors with new aluminum storefront windows and doors, and removal and replacement of the existing exterior hollow metal doors and frames with new hollow metal doors and frames.

A MANDATORY Pre-Bid Meeting will be held on Monday, October 28, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. in the Absalom Jones Senior Center for the purpose of establishing the listing of subcontractors and to answer questions. The successful bidder must post a performance bond and payment bond in a sum equal to 100 percent of the contract price upon execution of the contract. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities therein. The Owner may extend the time and place for the opening of the bids from that described in the advertisement, with not less than two calendar days notice by certified delivery, facsimile machine or other electronic means to those bidders' receiving plans.
