INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids for **OMB/DFM Contract No. MC5511000035A – Dover DMV/Public Safety Building – Roof Replacement**, will be received by the State of Delaware, Office of Management and Budget, Division of Facilities Management, in the reception area of the Facilities Management Office in the Haslet Armory, 122 Martin Luther King Blvd. South, Dover DE 19901 until 1:00pm local time on June 6, 2025, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Conference Room 133. Bidder bears the risk of late delivery. Any bids received after the stated time will be returned unopened.

Project involves removal and replacement of approximately 21,600 square feet of low-slope roofing at the Dover DMV Public Safety Building in Dover, Delaware. The scope also includes a complete metal coping replacement and miscellaneous improvements associated with the roof system.

A **MANDATORY** Pre-Bid Meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 21, 2025, at 10:00am at the Dover DMV Public Safety Building at 303 Transportation Circle, Dover, Delaware 19901 for the purpose of establishing the listing of subcontractors and to answer questions. Representatives of each party to any Joint Venture must attend this meeting. **ATTENDANCE OF THIS MEETING IS A PREREQUISITE FOR BIDDING ON THIS CONTRACT.**

Sealed bids shall be addressed to the Division of Facilities Management, Haslet Armory, 122 Martin Luther King Blvd. South, Dover DE 19901. The outer envelope should clearly indicate: **"OMB/DFM CONTRACT NO. MC5511000035A – DOVER DMV/PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING – ROOF REPLACEMENT - SEALED BID - DO NOT OPEN."**

Bidders will not be subject to discrimination on the basis of race, creed, color, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity or national origin in consideration of this award, and Minority Business Enterprises, Disadvantaged Business Enterprises, Women-Owned Business Enterprises and Veteran-Owned Business Enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids on this contract. Each bid must be accompanied by a bid security equivalent to ten percent of the bid amount and all additive alternates. The successful bidder must post a performance bond and payment bond in a sum equal to 100 percent of the contract price upon execution of the contract. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities therein. The Owner may extend the time and place for the opening of the bids from that described in the advertisement, with not less than two calendar days notice by certified delivery, facsimile machine or other electronic means to those bidders receiving plans.
