GENERAL STATEMENT:

- A. The Mandatory Pre-bid meeting was held at the Carvel State Office Building 1st floor DFM Conference Room at 820 N. French Street, Wilmington, DE 19801 at 9:30 AM on Wednesday June 26, 2024.

ITEMS DISCUSSED:

A. Key dates

1. **Bid Due – November 21st, 2024 at 1:00 p.m. in the Haslet Armory, 122 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. South as described in the Invitation to Bid of the specifications.**
2. **Bid Opening – November 21st, 2024 at 1:00 p.m. in the Haslet Armory, 122 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. South in Conference Room 133.**
3. **Questions deadline is Wednesday November 13th, 2024 at 4:00 PM. All questions must be submitted in writing and E-mailed to mlano@dedc-eng.com and jpetty@dedc-eng.com. Phone calls will not be accepted.**
4. **Please note that these dates have changed following the pre-bid meeting.**

B. Key topics

1. Bids

- a. The contractor must use the bid bond and bid form supplied in the project manual.
- b. Each bidder shall include a signed Affidavit for the Bidder certifying compliance with OMB Regulation 4104 - “Regulations for the Drug Testing of Contractor and Subcontractor Employees Working on “Large Public Works Projects.” “Large Public Works” is based upon the current threshold required for bidding Public Works as set by the Purchasing and Contracting Advisory Council.
- c. Make sure you identify your project name & number (MJ1002000079) on the front of your envelope when you submit your bid.
- d. Contract documents may be obtained at the office of DEDC, LLC, 315 S. Chapel Street Newark, Delaware 19711, phone 302-738-7172, upon receipt of the \$100.00 per paper set or \$25.00 per electronic set, both non-refundable. Checks are to be made payable to “DEDCC, LLC”.
- e. There is a \$50,000 allowance to be included in the base bid for use upon the owner’s instructions for any miscellaneous items found during construction. This allowance may only be billed against with the owner’s written approval.



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2. Building Access
 - a. A walkthrough will be conducted immediately following the pre bid.
3. Clarifications
 - a. All permits required for this effort to be obtained by the contractor.
 - b. The General Contractor who is bidding the project shall have a full-time superintendent or working foreman during the duration of construction.
 - c. This is a Delaware Prevailing Wage project (New Castle County).
 - d. There are (5) five subcontractor listings on this project: Mechanical, Electrical, ACT Ceiling, Sprinkler, and Controls. These Subcontractors are identified on the revised bid form included with this addendum.
 - e. Be sure to list your company name if your company is performing this work.
 - f. All companies listed must be registered in the State of Delaware to perform this work.
 - g. Normal work hours are 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. during the week. Off hours will need to be coordinated with DFM/OMB. All work outside of the mechanical room is to be completed during off-hours
 - h. There is existing furniture, carpeting, and other finishes in the work area that are to be adequately protected during construction.
 - i. A DTI approved structured cabling contractor must be utilized for all structured cabling on this project. A list of approved structured cabling contractors can be found here: <https://mmp.delaware.gov/Contracts/Details/5315>
 - j. In addition to the manufacturer requirements, the structured cabling contractor must abide by the DTI Standard ID: NE-Cabling-002 "Structured Cabling System Standards and Specifications for State-Managed Facilities" Revision #8 dated 1/29/21 and can be found here: <https://webfiles.dti.delaware.gov/pdfs/pp/CablingAndWiringStandard.pdf>
 - k. The contractor is responsible for cleaning up each night to ensure that normal State activities can continue during normal work hours.
 - l. The contractor is responsible for ensuring that anticipated lead times are factored into the contract duration the contractor identifies on the bid form.



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C. Meetings/Scheduling/Shutdowns

1. There will be progress meetings on this project every 2 weeks on a specific day and time, to be determined at the kickoff meeting.
2. Contractor to provide a full schedule before the project is to begin. It is the contractor's responsibility to ensure all equipment/material lead times meet the project schedule.
3. Contractors shall provide 3 – week look ahead schedule at each meeting to indicate work areas and shutdowns.
4. Any building systems shutdowns must be requested with at least 14 calendar days written request. The State will make every effort to coordinate a reasonable time for shutdowns based on coordination of manpower and critical State Agency activity schedules.
5. For the purpose of providing notice to building occupants, as the work progresses, at least 7 days written notice to the DFM Project Manager is required when the contractor intends to mobilize, re-mobilize, close any area of the building or access to any areas, and/or transition to and/or perform work in a new area of the building. The written notification must include details such as: When will the work start? Where/what areas of the building will be affected? How long will the area be affected? When will the work in this new area be complete?
