INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids for OMB/DFM Contract No. 2-26-53, will be received by the **Red Clay Consolidated School District on April 6, 2026 at 11:00am at Red Clay Facilities Office, 1798 Limestone Road, Wilmington, DE 19804, in the Conference Room**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bidder bears the risk of late delivery. Any bids received after the stated time will be returned unopened.

Project includes but is not limited to the complete removal and replacement of existing roof and insulation across entire school building. Existing mechanical, electrical, and plumbing and other rooftop equipment has been identified through the roof areas. Equipment and curbs are to be removed and reinstalled as indicated throughout the drawings. Structural drawings have been included for existing roof deck repair. Roof access ladders to be installed and replaced as indicated on drawings.

A **MANDATORY** Pre-Bid Meeting will be held on **Tuesday, March 20, 2026 at 2:00pm at Stanton Middle School, 1800 Limestone Road, Wilmington, DE 19804** for the purpose of establishing the listing of subcontractors and to answer questions.
